A. Rules review- Indoor/Outdoor

1. Yellow Card Proposal- Jen Slater Unruh- Proposed that she would like to see when a field player receives a yellow card, they step off the field until the next stoppage of play. Then they may return as soon as the next stoppage is available after caution. Goal keepers are exempt to the yellow step off rule. APPROVED.

2. Player Formal Complaint- Matt Arp- Proposed that if you have a problem with a player, you can

submit a formal complaint against that player. If the player gets 3 complaints- out from Leagues. DISCUSSED BUT NOT APPROVED.

3. James Oppenheimer- reporting yellow cards?? Jen suggests maybe asking Refs to report yellow cards to “see” who is regularly getting yellow cards?? Jim Marks- Referee definition of aggressive play that warrants a yellow card. Matt- coaches need to call out the aggressive player on their team and tell them to cool it. Need to add into rules – Tracking of the yellow cards; if you receive 3 yellow cards within a season, then they will be suspended for 1 game and a \$25 fine. No forgiveness of fee available and the suspension will carry over to the next season. Treated same as a red card. APPROVED.

4. Players playing in a different Leagues- James Oppenheimer- Proposed that he would like to see a player to have the availability to move up to guest play in any division available but a player may only be able to move down 1 League. APPROVED.
